BIODIVERSITY IN YOUR BACKYARD

Explore how interconnected biodiversity is with stewardship using our backyard ecosystems. We will use an interactive map to explore Howe Sound, learn how to identify whales and map their locations, delve into the world of plastics in the ocean and discuss the importance of biodiversity and stewardship in healthy ecosystems by going on a virtual beach walk through our live aquatic classroom.

What do animals need, and what makes a home? In this series, we'll explore our sense of place along with the roles, rights, and responsibilities we have to the ecosystems that we are a part of.

Recommended for Grades 1-3

OUR BEACH OUR HOME

Become a better explorer and ambassador for your local beach. Discuss how we rely on and impact our ocean. Explore and learn about how Indigenous diets continue to depend on the health of the land and oceans, how colonization has impacted Indigenous Peoples' ability to survive, and how to respect the importance of the land, animals, and water.
